GENERAL INFO:

The City Council approved the **removal** of five traffic signals around town. Those signals are at Broadway & Lindsay, **Broadway & Shoup, Yellowstone & A Street, Yellowstone & B Street**, and 17th & June. There will be a pedestrian flashing light installed at Yellowstone and B Street. City engineer Kent Fugal said the signals should be removed over the next month or two. They are hoping to improve traffic flow with these changes.
